2021 CEPS Kindergarten Orientation Program Overview

Our Kindergarten Orientation Program will give children an opportunity to participate in some 'real' class activities in the Kindergarten classrooms.

<i>Corrimal East Public School Kindergarten (2022) Orientation Program</i>	
Tuesday 30th November, 2021	9:30am – 10:30am Children are required to bring their filled drink bottle.
Tuesday 7th December, 2021	9:30am – 10:30am Children are required to bring their filled drink bottle.

Parents will leave their child in the capable care of CEPS staff and come back to collect their child at finishing time.

Kinder Orientation Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

All parents/carers will need to sign in and show vaccination status before entering the school grounds.

Drop Off

- Staff will guide you to the designated drop off/pick up point - this will be outside the Kindergarten room (keeping 1.5 metres away from other adults)
- Staff members will collect your child from the designated area and take them to the Kindergarten room
- Parents will then be asked to leave the school grounds

Pick Up

- A staff member will guide you back to the designated pick up point (keeping 1.5 metres away from other adults)
- Parents must wait within the designated area
- Staff members will walk your child to the designated area to greet you once the program has finished

Parents are asked to please bring the completed Kindergarten Orientation form on the first day.
