



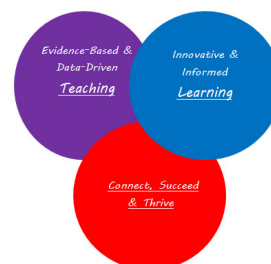

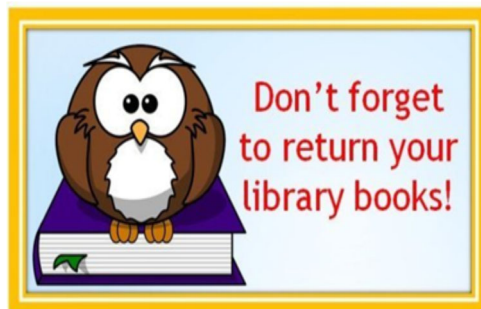
Library News
