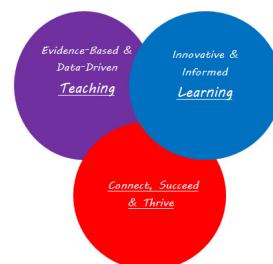

### South Coast School Sports Association District Restructure 2020

For many years now, there have been large inequities in the makeup of South Coast sport districts. The last formal restructure was in 1971. The South Coast SSA Council have decided that as of 2020, the South Coast SSA will no longer be made up of 16 districts, it will be made up of 13 districts.

As Brokers PSSA was one of the smaller districts, it was decided that Brokers PSSA would merge with Central Wollongong PSSA and North Wollongong PSSA and the Brokers district will cease.

#### Corrimal East PS will join North Wollongong PSSA as of 2020.

This merge will have an effect on student representation at district levels as our school will be now one of 17 schools in the new district, however the strength of the district will now be considerably stronger. Tarrwanna PS and Towradgi PS will also join North Wollongong PSSA. Students 3-6 will be participating in PSSA Sport as of 2020; mor einfo about thi s in 2020.

### 'Have You Heard Of The Wickety Wocket?' Show Information

Dear Parents,

Our whole school production is approaching very quickly (Wednesday 4th December)! Below are various pieces of information that you need to be aware of so that the day and night run smoothly.

Tickets are selling fast. We will cap the number of tickets sold for both the matinee and evening performances so get in quick to avoid disappointment. There will be **NO TICKETS SOLD ON THE DAY!**

#### **Show Day Information**

The back bottom school gate will be open for the day performance and the night performance to make parking and access to the school easier. Please note there is no interval and that all mobile phones must be turned off. Toddlers are to remain with their parents at all times (no playing either in the hall or outside of the hall will be permitted).

#### **11.30am performance**

**Students** are to arrive at school, in their school uniform, as per any other school day (before 9am). Students will then have recess from 10.15-10.45am before returning to their classrooms to get dressed in their costumes. Following the show students will then return to their classrooms and change back into their school uniform, leaving their costume with their class teacher ready for the night time performance. Students are to remain at school until 3pm.

**Audience-** Doors for the show to open at 11.15am. Once all tickets have been collected and all audience members are seated the show will begin. Following the finale the audience is asked to remain in their seats whilst all students return to their classrooms to get changed.

#### **7:00pm performance**

#### **ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE EVENING PERFORMANCE!**

**Students** are to come to school with an adult. They may wear weekend clothes. Please ensure they have had something to eat and drink. They may bring some snacks and a drink bottle with water to their classrooms. **Students need to be signed in to their classroom teacher at 6pm.** They will then be given time to get changed into their costumes. Students will remain with their teacher until their individual dance, returning to their classroom to wait until the finale dance. Following the finale dance all students will return to their classrooms and get changed back into their own clothing. Once this occurs parents can collect their child/ren from their classroom. Please understand that this may take some time. We know parents will be excited following the amazing performances but safety is our priority. Students must remain in their classroom until a parent has signed them out. **All students must be signed out at their classroom.**

**Audience-** Doors for the show to open at 6.45pm. Once all tickets have been collected and all audience members are seated the show will begin. Following the finale the audience is asked to remain in their seats whilst all students return to their classrooms to get changed. Once this occurs you may collect your child/ren, **ensuring you sign them out with the classroom teacher.**

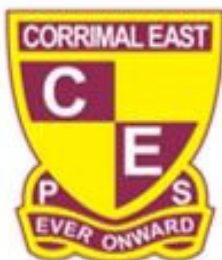
