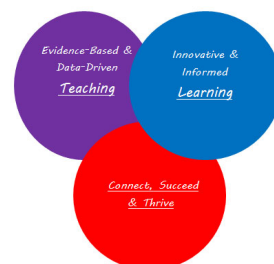

South Coast Athletics

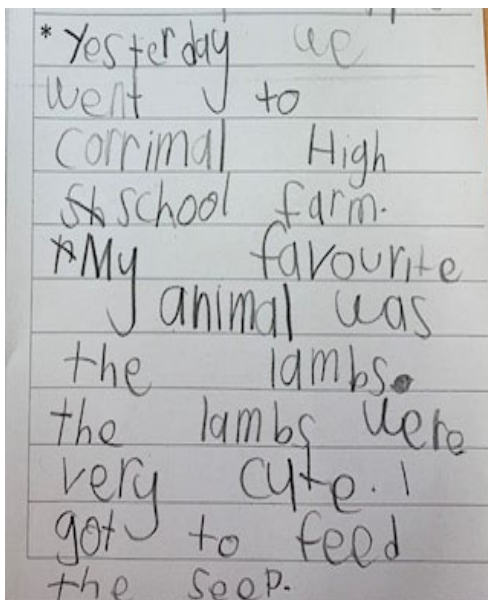
