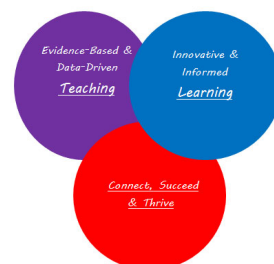

Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we had the privilege of a visit from an internationally acclaimed Indigenous artist, Daren Dunn who came to work with our Aboriginal students. Daren was the 2015 Indigenous artist of the year. He is a proud Gamilaroi man from New South Wales and world-renowned artist who has exhibited in Italy, Russia, Ireland, China, the United States and Japan. Not limited to the canvas, Daren has hand painted a cricket bat for Prince William, high heels for Princess Kate, a golf bag for Tiger Woods and Football boots for David Beckham! A dedicated educator, Daren has worked with Indigenous youth for 23 years. His passions are sharing his knowledge and skills in art, fostering a love and respect for Aboriginal culture and giving back to the community. Daren's main goal in his work with students is to ensure sustainability in Indigenous education for future generations. We are hoping to get Daren back again next year to continue to work with all of our students.

With the constant changes in weather we have had a number of children coming to school sick with cold or flu like symptoms. It is really important that you keep your child at home if they are sick. If symptoms are presented during the school day, the office staff will call for someone to come and collect the sick child.

We are really looking forward to having our new 2021 Kindergarten students to CEPS in the coming weeks for orientation. 2020 CEPS Kindergarten Orientation Program Overview

Our Kindergarten Orientation Program will give children an opportunity to participate in some 'real' class activities in the Kindergarten classrooms.

Corrimal East Public School Kindergarten (2021) Orientation Program	
Friday 20th November, 2020	9:30am – 10:30am Children are required to bring their filled drink bottle.
Friday 27th November, 2020	9:30am – 10:30am Children are required to bring their filled drink bottle.
Friday 4th December, 2020	9:30am – 10:30am Children are required to bring their filled drink bottle.

Parents will leave their child in the capable care of CEPS staff and come back to collect their child at finishing time.

Kinder Orientation Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

Drop Off

- Staff will guide you to the designated drop off/pick up point - this will be outside the Kindergarten room (keeping 1.5 metres away from other adults)
- Staff members and the Year 6 Leaders will collect your child from the designated area and take them to the Kindergarten room
- Parents will then be asked to leave the school grounds

Pick Up

- A staff member will guide you back to the designated pick up point (keeping 1.5 metres away from other adults)
- Parents must wait within the designated area
- Staff members will walk your child to the designated area to greet you once the program has finished

Parents are asked to please bring the completed Kindergarten Orientation form and external visitor form to the first orientation day.

Parent/Family Involvement During Orientation

While we would usually have a parent information session where parents have the opportunity to meet other parents and staff, the current department guidelines reinforce that schools must limit the amount of adults entering the school grounds and so we are therefore unable to hold events with groups of adults.

In place of this we are currently developing a Kindergarten orientation video to introduce you to our wonderful school.

Am I eligible for *Learning for Life*?

To be eligible, you must:

- ✓ Have a child/ children in Kindergarten/ Prep/ Reception to Year 6, who attend a school that we work with
- ✓ Have a current Health Care or Pension Concession Card
- ✓ Demonstrate a strong commitment to education through regular school attendance



What else do I need to know?

Learning for Life is a partnership between your family and The Smith Family.

As a parent/guardian or caregiver, you will be committing to:

- Your children attending school regularly
- Providing a school report yearly for each child
- Returning a yearly progress report for each child
- Maintaining contact with The Smith Family



How do I apply for *Learning for Life*?

If you meet all of the above criteria and would like to apply for the *Learning for Life* program, please complete the referral form provided and return to your school.
