



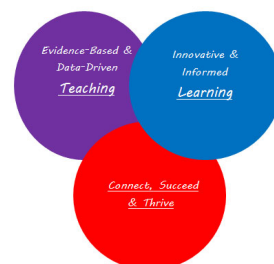

Continual Whoop

Evacuate room or playground and walk quickly and calmly to the cricket pitch
Sit in class groups
Remain at the cricket pitch and await directions from the Principal
Office staff to bring required materials

All Areas Emergency Lock-Down Procedures

Continual Beep

Pull all curtains down and lock door
DO NOT let any student leave the classroom for ANY reason
DO NOT open any door for ANY reason
Remain in the classroom and await directions from the Principal

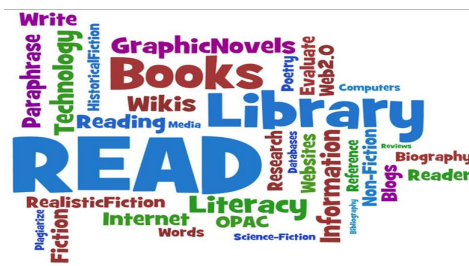
Each class at CEPS has an allocation of 1 hour per week in our lovely school Library with Mrs Taylor.

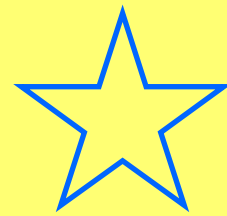
