



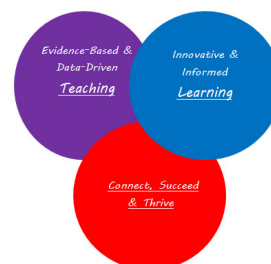

Dear Parents,

On Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th September, students from Stage 2 will be attending an excursion to Sydney Harbour and ZooSnooz. This excursion forms part of our study of History and 'First Contacts' along with our Geography unit 'The Earth's Environment' where students explore the climate, natural vegetation and native animals of places in Australia and Asia.

Venue: Taronga Park Zoo

Travel: Seat belted coach

Cost: \$155.00

What to wear: Comfortable walking shoes and clothes for all seasons (details to follow)

Pick up and return to school times: Bus will leave 9 am on Thursday, 3rd September and return approximately 3:15-3:30pm Friday, 4th September.

What food to take: Lunch and snacks for the first day.

Students will need:

Sleeping bag, pillow, toothbrush/toiletries, pyjamas, comfortable walking shoes and weather appropriate clothing.

A torch is encouraged for use in the sleeping areas, though it will not be needed on the night walk.

ZooSnooz is an all-weather program and students are expected to bring appropriate wear such as raincoats, warm layers etc. if needed. As part of the program we will be going on a night walk, so warm layers are a great idea!

A day pack with water bottle, hat, sunscreen, camera.

Of course we would like for all students to be able to participate in this wonderful experience. Although, all students have been spoken to about the imperative need for them to be safe, responsible and respectful members of our school community each and every day so that they show all staff that they can be trusted to take away, out of the school setting. 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2020 Stage 3 Camp Morisset Outdoor Education Group POP: Morisset Camp

Dear Parents,

As part of Stage 3's teaching and learning program, a four day/three night camp has been organised for your child in **Term 4, Week 1 from Tuesday 13th to Friday 16th October at Camp Morisset with the Outdoor Education Group (OEG).**

All of the staff at OEG are ready to give your son/daughter a positive and memorable experience. OEG staff set high standards of safety and students will be accompanied by the teachers from Corrimal East Public School during all activities.

OEG has a strict policy of 'challenge by choice', i.e. everyone is encouraged to give it their best, but no one is forced to do anything. The program of activities chosen are challenging, educational and lots of fun.

Your son/daughter will be informed of the camp rules on arrival and will be expected to carry out those safety rules during the program. The International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) is an independent, quality skills-based assessment program which rewards and recognises achievement. **Students in Years 3 – 6** will have the opportunity to participate in voluntary ICAS assessments in the areas of Science, Writing, Spelling, English and Mathematics. Each assessment has an individual associated cost and needs to be paid in full prior to participation in the ICAS assessments.

Each student receives:

- an individual diagnostic report highlighting strengths and weaknesses and year to year progression
- login details to access their online results which can be analysed and downloaded
- a High Distinction, Distinction, Credit, Merit or Participation Certificate acknowledging their level of achievement
- the chance to receive an individually-engraved UNSW medal for the highest scoring student in each year level for each subject.

This year we are offering ICAS assessments to **students in Years 3-6 only**. To enrol your child in any or all of the ICAS assessments, please complete the registration form and return it, with your entry fees (**non-refundable**), no later than **Friday the 27th March, 2020**. Please note, no late entries can be accepted.
