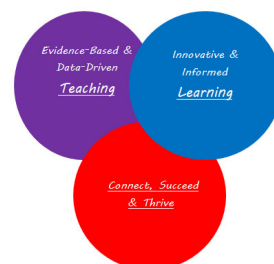

Dear Parents / Caregivers

Students have been busy learning from home again this week. Remember that every student must show their work to their classroom teacher. Years K-1 will take a picture and put it on Seesaw. Years 2-6 are required to submit their work on Google Classroom.

Work needs to be submitted every day. Teachers are marking the roll based on who has and hasn't submitted work. If your child submits work either through Seesaw (K-1) or on Google Classroom (2-6) they will be marked as present using a flexible code. If your child does not submit work they will be marked as absent with no explanation. This is a department requirement that roles are marked each and every day.

Stay connected



Workspace

Focus

During calls with your teacher, stay focused on the call. Avoid reading chats or looking at other tabs.

Ask questions
