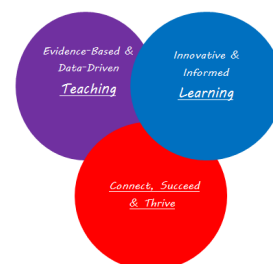

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

## Student Banking Resumes Next Week

Student Banking will resume for term 3 next week. CEPS participates in the Commonwealth Bank School Banking program which provides students with an opportunity to make deposits into their Youthsaver account at school each week. The program rewards how often students deposit, not how much they deposit. Students receive a token every time they bank and when they receive 10 tokens they are eligible to choose a reward. If you are interested in starting an account for your child please phone the office for an application form. Our **school banking day is Tuesday**. Students place their bank book in the Student banking slot in the class foyer, the office processes the deposits, and the bank books are returned to the students for the following week.
