COVID TESTING - INFORMING THE SCHOOL



- For a quick start, just click on **ORDER** in the top menu or **REGISTER** first to save your details for next time
- Select your school and your child's class
- Add your child's first name and last initial (so the school knows who the book is for)
- Enter the item number from the Book Club catalogue
- You can order for multiple children at once if they attend the same school
- All orders are linked directly to the school for submission to Scholastic. Books will still be delivered to your child's classroom if you order by the close date
- There's no need to return paper order forms or payment receipt details to your school!

Students will be skipping throughout the term with their class and have the option to continue during lunch breaks. We will hold our school **Jump Off Day** on the 11th of September. This will mark the end of the program and is a chance for all students to come together to skip and show off their newly learned skills.

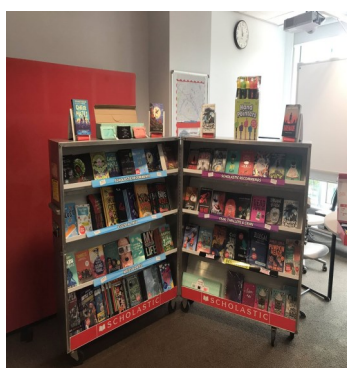

The book cases were delivered to our school library on Monday for the students to begin viewing their item they might like to purchase.

N.B. Please be aware parents are not able to view the books online, students must :

1. Choose their selections and write them on their wish list
2. Bring their wish list home to their parents
3. Upon deciding which items to buy, purchase one of two ways-by cash (your child will bring this to school with them) or online payment to scholastic (see reverse side of wish list for instructions)

Viewing Times For Students: From Tuesday 1st - Friday 4th September, students, in their library session, were able to view all the books, book packs, kits and stationary items that are available for purchase. Students then created a 'Wish List' of the items that they would love to purchase.

Purchase Times: From Tuesday 8th - Friday 11th September between 8:30am - 9:00am and 11:00am - 11:30am students may bring their wish list or their completed online payment slip to the library to purchase their books.

The flyer attached shows a selection of some of the Book Fair books for purchase, which start at only \$5 and the details regarding the **paying online option** which is available. After the online payment is made, students bring the **Wish List Payment Form** to school which has the **Payment Receipt** information. Students may also bring **cash** to school to purchase their books.

Sadly, we will not be holding a Book Character Parade in 2020.

In lieu of the Book Character Parade, we will be having a **Bamboozled Mufti Day** on **Wednesday 9th September** instead. This is based on the topsy turvy themed book 'Bamboozled' by David Legge where the unusual is the normal. We have talked about ideas regarding what to wear in our library sessions this week. E.g. pyjama pants with gumboots and a tutu, odd socks, hair styled in different ways, back to front wearing of clothes etc.

- ✓ Have a current Health Care or Pension Concession Card
- ✓ Demonstrate a strong commitment to education through regular school attendance



What else do I need to know?

Learning for Life is a partnership between your family and The Smith Family.

As a parent/guardian or caregiver, you will be committing to:

- Your children attending school regularly
- Providing a school report yearly for each child
- Returning a yearly progress report for each child
- Maintaining contact with The Smith Family
